Introduced the UP_TVET System as a single platform for applying to TVET courses across various ministries, offering year-round application flexibility while expanding opportunities for Malaysians to access TVET education.



Represented Malaysia at the 2024 Asia-Pacific Ministerial Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction (APMCDRR) in the Philippines and 12th Asean Ministerial Meeting on Disaster Management (AMMDM) in Brunei, to strengthen national disaster risk management.



Re-organised the Bumiputera Economic Congress (KEB) which outlined three goals, six commitments and three efforts as part of the Bumiputera Economic Transformation Plan 2035 (PuTERA35), which will foster a more positive, progressive and innovative Bumiputera agenda.

Increased the employability rate of TVET graduates to 94.5%, highlighting the high demand for skilled labour in technical and vocational sectors in Malaysia.



Developed Malaysia's largest grid-connected palm-effluent Biogas Power Plant, in collaboration with Cenergi through FELCRA Jayaputra, with a capacity of **5.5MW**. The plant has also been recognised by the Malaysia Book of Records and is capable of supplying electricity to

capable of supplying electricity to nearly 14,000 households or roughly 70,000 rural residents.



Organised the FELDA Settlers Day (HPF) 2024 celebration which successfully attracted over 500,000 visitors throughout the three-day event.



Lead RISDA Holdings Group to achieve a financial performance of **RM37mil**, with a projected performance of **RM70mil** by the end of December.



Enrollment in TVET programmes increased to 175,780 individuals in 2023, compared to 130,440 in 2020. TVET enrollment also recorded its highest number in 2023, reaching 407,038 individuals.



Recorded a 168% increase in Interim Distributable Profits 2 for 2024, compared to the same period last year, with a total distribution of RM129mil to nearly 68,000 successful FELCRA project participants.



Produced 3,077 TVET technopreneurs among TVET students through various entrepreneurship programmes and technopreneurship clusters, including fields such as fabrics, landscaping, fumiture, fashion, electrical and air conditioning.



7,295 MARA business premises achieved a 91% occupancy rate which contributed RM1.77bil in total sales and created 14,233 job opportunities.



Reduced approximately 5% of idle land in Kedah through agricultural projects, increasing Kedah Regional Development Authority (KEDA) participants' income by 30%.



A total of 838 Orang Asli students received sponsorships from Department of Indigenous People Development (JAKOA) to pursue higher education at institutions of higher learning (IPT) from 2023 to 2024.
