

# Used car checklist

## 1 Year of manufacture

Check the Vehicle Identification Number for details.



## 2 Car mileage

Advisable to divide odometer figure by the car's age. High-mileage cars can be difficult to start.



## 3 Accident and service records

Observe imbalanced alignment or noticeable damages. Check the maintenance booklet. If unavailable, ask the previous owner for service receipts.

## 4 Exterior/interior condition

Inspect for signs of damage or defects. Extensive wear of car seat upholstery shows heavy usage and poor maintenance.



## 7 Test drive

Listen for unusual sounds and observe if there are faulty gear shifts.



## 6 Car warranty

Check if the manufacturer's warranty is still valid.



## 5 Engine condition

Check for leakages, electrical connections and ensure all parts are in good condition.
