Two special programmes endorsed by Leong are Shiatsu Stretching and Thai Rolling.

These programmes enable a fullbody stretch and help with body alignment, which promotes blood circulation.

Lastly, it also has 4D reflexology consisting of 4D roller foot guasa that massages 360° on the calves,

ankle and sole that targets acupressure points to release toxins and promote blood circulation.

The S7 SuperChAiR's speciality is its twin 4D Roller that uses double kneading and shiatsu technique with protrusion up to 12cm + shiatsu 3cm to target the sciatic nerve – the largest and longest nerve in the body.

Massages on this nerve can help prevent frozen shoulder or backache. This twin 4D roller can be combined into one big roller that massages from upper body to the lower body and vice versa for overall relief of muscle tension and promoting relaxation.

It also has 4D reflexology that massages 360° on the calves, ankle and sole. The speciality of this reflexology is that it has ankle/knee traction to promote proper alignment.

The S9 SuperChAiR is the newly launched and latest model.

It is the first 6D Dual Hand massage chair as the massage track is segmented into two parts, with 15cm protrusion on the upper body and 12cm protrusion on the lower body that helps with deep tissue massage.

The 6D Dual Hand massage is specially designed and incorporated with the massage programmes to help reduce mental stress, relieve muscle ache and overall body stiffness.

It also has two programmes created on consultation and endorsed by Leong, which are Master Stretch and Thai Rolling.

These provide full body stretching at 230° and also help ensure proper body alignment.

It also has the most airbags at a total of 72 Cocoons Airbags, which compression helps stimulate blood flow throughout the body and prevent blood clots.

Meanwhile, a 100% full coverage reflexology with its three spiky rollers and 18-piece airbag on the footrest combine heat therapy to help reduce body toxins, stimulate the nervous system, improve blood flow and reduce overall stress and anxiety.

For a more comfortable bed

YOUR bed should be cosy and comfortable as you will be spending every night on it. Here are some tips to make your bed as comfortable as possible.

Use a bolster

There's a gap between the headboard and the mattress, so fill it with a bolster. This also makes reading in bed a more comfortable experience than piling pillows.

Go for linen or cotton

At night your body heats so you sweat. Nylon and artificial fibres can make this an uncomfortable experience. Go for natural fibres.

Ditch pretty discomforts

Ask yourself whether you want the dozen throw pillows on your bed, or the cover that has to come off before you can lie down. Focus on what is "you" and remove everything else that gets in the way of a good night's sleep.

Handy tips on painting walls

START with good tools: a strong ladder, the right tape and ergonomic brushes.

Popcorn ceilings? No problem. You don't have to scrape and skim coat them if your time and budget won't allow it.

A matte finish in a deep shade will minimise the textured effect. Don't use gloss paints unless your ceiling is in excellent condition.

A lighter colour than the walls makes them look taller. Black and near-black also create a more expansive effect. Warm colours make the room come down, like a hug.

A trick for making a tall room feel cosier: Paint the ceiling a different colour from the walls, and bring that ceiling colour down 1m or so into the walls.

Use a colour that varies from the walls and trim.

Timid about a ceiling colour outside of white? Try a yellowtinted white that can add warmth to the room, or a white with a touch of pink, which is flattering to all skin tones.

And, of course, sky blue is a classic. — The Kansas City Star/ McClatchy-Tribune Information Services
