My journey through Chinese Medicine at IMU has been a continuous and enriching experience. I vividly remember what inspired me to begin this path – my enduring struggle with chronic skin conditions drove me to seek holistic healing, sparking a deep interest in Chinese Medicine.

Embarking on the study of Chinese Medicine was initially challenging, given its abstract concepts, the need for a vivid imagination, and some philosophical understanding.

Thankfully, our dedicated lecturers spared no effort in clarifying these complexities, patiently guiding us in building a strong foundation in Chinese Medicine knowledge

In my second year, the global outbreak of Covid-19 disrupted our lives, prompting a shift to online learning. Adapting to this new modality was challenging for everyone, but IMU's swift response ensured the seamless continuation of classes.

Despite these efforts, I faced moments of anxiety and uncertainty, compounded by some personal factors, which led me to make a bold decision in my third year – taking a one-year break from my studies.

Accounting principles and auditing will be taught to students, as well as the most recent developments in economics, management, marketing, finance, and insurance. This programme provides students with a solid foundation for mastering

theory and techniques in order to understand financial and accounting activities. Topics of study include economics, information technology and accounting law.

Students with three credits in mathematics, science and any other subject in the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) or recognised certificates can expect a conducive learning environment and high-calibre academics with years of practice and experience in the field.

Credit transfer allows MSU College graduates to pursue a second-year bachelor's degree at Management and Science University (MSU) through its Faculty of **Business Management and Professional** Studies (FMBP).

Students are also encouraged to pursue additional accounting certifications such

as the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) or Certified Accounting Technician (CAT) in order to increase their earning power. Other programmes offered by SHB include Early Childhood Education, Management and English Language Teaching (ELT).

MSU College is also an MSU APEL Centre for potential candidates to take the APEL Aptitude Test as the non-conventional pre-qualification for entry into higher studies, in which MSU currently offers APEL A and APEL C at T-3 (certificate), T-4 (diploma), T-6 (bachelor's degree) and T-7 (master's degree) levels.

Financial aid opens doors for students

AS the cost of higher education continues to rise, the challenge of providing financial aid to students has increased. But for Tunku Abdul Rahman University of Management and Technology (TAR UMT), providing financial aid to deserving students to pursue their tertiary education is one of the core functions deeply rooted in the university's founding principles.

Over the years, TAR UMT's financial aid options have expanded to cater to the many interest-free student loan funds, and externally administered

financial aid such as the National Higher Education Fund Corporation (PTPTN), and Pembiayaan Pendidikan Boleh Ubah (PPBU) Yayasan Bank Rakyat.

One of the latest beneficiaries of the university's interest-free student loan fund is Tan Kian Hui, who was able to pursue the Foundation in Science programme at TAR UMT. Due to his family's financial constraints, Tan was initially unsure if he could further his studies after high

"My goal was always to further my studies and obtain a degree, but my family's financial situation is a huge challenge. I had to work part-time to help support my family, however, working part-time while also studying full-time was a huge challenge as it demanded a lot of physical and mental strength.

"I did not have much choice, but I did not give up on searching for a better solution to my predicament. Through online research, I found out about the TAR UMT student loan fund and immediately applied for assistance."

It was a tremendous relief for me and my family when my application was successful because I can now concentrate on my studies without the constant stress of figuring out how to afford the tuition fees," said Tan, whose dream is to have a bright career in the field of mechanical engineering. He also offered words of encourage-

ment to those seeking higher education who might be too shy to seek financial aid.

"I encourage my peers to stay focused on their education goals and not to feel discouraged. Numerous financial aid options are available to support their studies. Furthermore, a dedicated financial aid team on campus provides guidance to qualified students throughout the application process," he added.

Tan is among the more than 16,000

students of the university who benefited from the revolving interest-free student loan fund which was established in 1979.

Similar to Tan, Teo Kah Chin was also a recipient of the university's student loan fund. The only difference is he received financial assistance over 30 years ago, and graduated with a Diploma in Technology (Electronics Engineering) in 1990 from the then TAR College.

"I remember that I was not able to be completely happy upon receiving the acceptance letter from the then TAR College because my family's financial background could not support my higher education.

"However, I still went to college on the first day with this worry in mind, and I was relieved when I learnt about the institution offering financial aid during one of the briefing sessions," he reminisced. The financial aid was a much-needed

lifeline for Teo, and thanks to the qualification and skills he acquired at TAR UMT, he continued to excel as a quality assurance engineering assistant for many

"The loan fund was a lifesaver for me and my family. It helped me achieve my academic goals, opened doors to countless opportunities after my graduation, and made me who I am today.

"I would not have achieved what I am doing now if not for the financial support from the TARC student loan fund (now known as TAR UMT Student Loan Fund)," he added.


